



Secretary of the Pennsylvania House of Representatives

Act 232 of 1939 created the position of Secretary of the House of Representatives. The duties had been transferred from the recently abolished offices of Resident Clerk and Assistant Resident Clerk. These included printing bills and journals, preparing calendars for the Members, and maintaining seat assignments for Members on the House floor.

The last Secretary of the House served in 1980 after the creation of the Bipartisan Management Committee transferred the duties to the offices under the Chief Clerk of the House.
